Abstract of medical record 1037957

Patient: Konstantin Zhivetyev, 26

Diagnosis: Submersio. St. postreanimationem. ARDS. Pneumonia ex aspiratione.

Insufficientia renum acuta. Laesio cerebri anoxica.

From 10.04.2010 the patient is being treated at the intensive care unit he was taken to by reanimobile team from the scene of the accident. The patient drowned in a river, was taken out of the water before the reanimobile arrived, heart massage was performed. Upon reanimobile arrival the patient was cyanotic, with mydriatic pupils, in pulmonary arrest, on the monitors - cardiac standstill. Resuscitation for 45 minutes.

On admission to ICU the patient is in critical condition: coma GSC= 3 points, mydriatic pupils, no corneal reflex; hypothermia 28°C, evident respiratory failure, hemodynamics is extremely unstable, signs of haemolysis.

For a week the patient was under deep narcosis, AVL with high dosage of O2, to support hemodynamics needed vasoconstrictors and inotropic therapy, continuous veno-venous hemofiltration (CVVH).

At this point the patient spontaneously opens his eyes, doesn't focus, doesn't respond to commands, no purposive movements, occasional muscular twitching, spasticity of lower limbs. The patient is on spontaneous breathing through tracheostomy cannula. Blood gases are normal. Hemodynamics is stable, hypertensia tendency. Renal function is restoring, the patient doesn't need hemodialysis.

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
